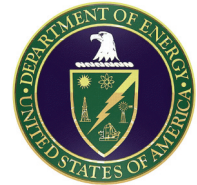

PROJECT DETAILS

Size: Five building campus, over 1.5 million square feet

TELECOM/AV Cost: Estimated to exceed \$15M

Responsibility: TELECOM/AV engineer of record, project management, installation and testing

BACKGROUND

The National Nuclear Security Administration (KCRIMS) campus currently under construction will be ready for occupancy in 2012. The five building campus project is projected to cost \$687 million dollars. This 1.5 million square foot campus will be a LEED GOLD Facility that will house 2,500 employees. WhiteOak Group has been selected as the Telecommunications and Audiovisual Engineer of Record. These newly designed TELECOM networks and AV facilities will support manufacturing, lab, and office and warehouse workspace.

SCOPE

Telecommunications and audiovisual design and engineering, CAD drawing development, procurement and installation of materials. Testing of classified and unclassified network systems.
